The purpose of this amendment is to answer questions received via email and during the pre-proposal conference. The questions asked and AMS' answers to them are as follow:

1) Question: Please clarify Grade. Has Grade A been removed?

Answer: Grade A quality requirement remains for consumer pack whole birds and spilt breasts. Drumsticks and thighs are Grade A for all factors except US Grade B for exposed flesh. Leg Quarters are us Grade B or better.

2) Question: Is there any way to deviate on the leg quarters from 8/5lb bags to 4/10lb bags?

Answer: There is no deviation allowed on the leg quarters. Must be 8/5 lb.

3) Question: What is the WOG size verification procedure?

Answer: QAD 607: "Select 10 units per sample when certifying weight range for poultry carcasses and parts. Product failing to meet the $\pm 10\%$ weight variation requirement will be retained back to the last acceptable sample. Retained product may be resampled on a stationary lot basis when requested by management."

4) Question: Review label requirement for each item:

Answer: FSIS approved commercial labels on individual packages and shipping containers for all items.

5) Question: Review packaging (tamper evident, give examples of what is acceptable and what is not acceptable):

Answer: Packages and shipping containers that are sealed are barriers to entry which meets the "one or more indicators" requirement.

6) Question: Tray size requirement on boneless skinless thigh (code 111002):

Answer: No specific tray size requirement..."commercially acceptable tray-pack-style packages, or similarly constructed materials comparable in design and style to commercial tray-pack packages."

7) Question: Purchase/delivery unit - what is the weight variation permitted for each item (for example, variation of minus 1% is permitted)?

Answer: Whole Chicken (100880) and Thighs (111002) – minus 1% is permitted, Split Breast (110154), Drumsticks (110090), Leg Quarters (110092), and Thighs (110195) – no variation,

8) Question: Marination allowance on any of the items?

Answer: No marination allowance on any of the items.

- 10) Question: Any deviation to use drumsticks from larger WOG, 8.5 to 9 pounds?

Answer: We must stick with the 3-6.5 lb WOG for household recipients to accept the 5 lb bag. For the broilers, you have both small and large bird plants, with this range it allows additional participation.

11) Question: Does plastic film bag have to be sealed and clear film bag?

Answer: Bags must be sealed and tamper evident. If bags are tampered with, you will know about it.

12) Question: How are Whole Bagged Chickens packed?

Answer: 10-12 bagged birds individualy bagged.

13) What is production date requirement?

Answer: The commodity shall not be processed or packaged more than 60 days prior to the first day of the delivery period.
