*******IMPORTANT TRADE MITIGATION SOLICITATION DETAILS*******

• This Invitation for Bid (Acquisition/Solicitation) is part of the Food Purchase and Distribution Program under the authority of the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC), the purpose of which is to assist Farmers in response to Trade damage from unjustified retaliation. Funding for this purchase is under Section 5 of the CCC Charter Act.

• In accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.203-2 Certificate of Independent Price Determination (Apr 1985) (as found in the System for Award Management (www.SAM.gov) Representations and Certifications) offerors have certified that the prices in their offer have been arrived at “independently, without, for the purpose of restricting competition, any consultation, communication, or agreement with any other offeror or competitor.”
