

REVISION HISTORY for PDP 1995 Public-Domain Database

8/10/2017 Revision: Revised the **1994-1996** and **2001-2002** public-domain databases and data ZIP files to eliminate the long-standing confusion with the Commodity Codes used for canned/frozen Sweet Corn and Sweet Peas. The CS and PS commodity codes had always been shared by canned and frozen samples. We replaced the commodity codes for Sweet Corn (CS) and Sweet Peas (PS) where the Commodity Type is "Canned" (commodity type code CA) with new "CD" and "SD" commodity codes. For historical counting and reporting purposes, it is better to have them separated since we count them as two separate commodities. This also resolved a glitch in the new online PDP Database Search app. With these changes, the "CS" commodity code refers to just Frozen Sweet Corn and "PS" refers to just Frozen Sweet Peas, while the new "CD" commodity code refers to just Canned Sweet Corn and the new "SD" commodity code refers to just Canned Sweet Peas.

Actions:

- 1) Updated value in COMMOD column of 95SampleData table to "CD" where COMMOD="CS" and COMMTYPE="CA". Changed 336 rows.
- 2) Updated value in COMMOD column of 95SampleData table to "SD" where COMMOD="PS" and COMMTYPE="CA". Changed 333 rows.
- 3) Updated value in COMMOD column of 95ResultsData table to "CD" where COMMOD="CS" and COMMTYPE="CA". Changed 20,874 rows.
- 3) Updated value in COMMOD column of 95ResultsData table to "SD" where COMMOD=" PS" and COMMTYPE="CA". Changed 20,254 rows.

5/26/2015 Revision: Revised the **1992-2013** data ZIP files to add tolerance tables for the 1992-2013 surveys to each downloadable ZIP file on the PDP Website. Populated a new ToleranceRef table in each PDPyyyy.mdb database file. Added Excel worksheets for the 1992-2013 tolerance tables into the Ref Tables Excel files included in the ZIP file. The new reference/look-up table holds established EPA Tolerance values for each reported pesticide/commodity pair.

12/10/2008 Revision: Revised the **1992-2006** public-domain databases and data ZIP files to incorporate a primary key value (SAMPLE_PK column) to link the Sample & Results data tables, designed to provide quicker searches and smaller databases. Published the ZIP files that contain the revised 1992-2006 databases along with supporting documentation (instructions, data dictionary, and reference table lists) to the PDP Website.
