

This information is prepared pursuant to Section \$1000.25 (c)(8) of the General Provisions of Federal Milk Marketing Orders, Part 1000 which is incorporated by reference and made a part of Federal Order Number 7. Part 1000 states that the Market Administrator shall "Prepare and disseminate publicly for the benefit of producers, handlers, and **consumers** such statistics and other information concerning operation of the order and facts relevant to the provisions thereof (or proposed provisions) as do not reveal confidential information."






