I would recommend two things:

- ① The manufacture make Allowance
be lowered to prior price reform
levels. Too much profit in the
manufacturing of milk into cheese
will cause AN over production of
cheese that the market can not
Absorb thus lowering the price of
not only cheese but class III milk
to the farmers. Most dairy
farmers are suffering through
prices below the cost of production
Now in the prices they receive for
cheese milk.
- ② The price moves being the higher
of class III or class IV has been
A very good change. This type of
pricing surely sends a signal to
the farmers producing for the
market. It also helps the fluid
producer who is not over producing.

I recommend these two principals
Very strongly.
