### **Educational Qualifications**

- Forest Service hires students through the Pathways Internship Program year round.
- Recruitment for these positions start as early as November of each year.

- Up-to-date college transcripts OR High School report Card. Unofficial transcripts/report cards or copies will be accepted if legible but must be include current GPA and degree program,
- Letter of Acceptance or Letter of Enrollment from educational institutions
- DD-214 (Member Copy 4) or other relevant documentation, if claiming Veteran's Preference,
- Apply to open vacancy announcements, and
- Submit online application.






